

PORTABULK brings further success for Goodtech

Goodtech Packaging Systems, Norway, has during the past two years commissioned fully automated, robot-operated PORTABULK® bulk bag filling lines to Yara's technical ammonium nitrate line at Koeping (Sweden); to Felleskjoepet - the leading Norwegian agricultural cooperative – at its Norwegian seed plant at Holstad, and for fish feed at the Ewos AS plant in Floroe, located on the Norwegian west coast. New projects, many of which also include fully integrated track and trace technology adapted to industrial IT solutions, are scheduled for implementation in the next 12 months. These include another Norwegian fish-feed major – Biomar – as part of its development at Myre; an extensive Felleskjoepet project, at the company's Kambo site, as well as contracts awarded by Ammophos, a Russian fertiliser conglomerate and the Romanian fertiliser supplier Azomures. www.goodtech.no
