

Low-budget manual inline sampler

Kersting, Brilon, Germany, has introduced the new series of SiloTasty and InlineTasty installed samplers which are suitable for use with all free flowing powders and granules up to a particle size of 8-10mm. They have been developed in answer to a growing demand for low-cost sampling systems suitable for a wide variety of applications. The new device is fabricated from food-grade materials, such as stainless steel 316 and Teflon polymers and for easy installation all connections are based on the Triclamp system. The Tasty line can be installed on silo cones, gravity chutes and down pipes as well as on pneumatic conveying lines where it has been tested for pressures up to 5 barg. Sampling takes place when the hand lever is engaged. There are various choices of sample collection such as bag holder, endless liner system or customised bottle connector. An optional ball valve ensures reproducible samples of equal quantities (0.4 litres). www.kersting-ind.de
