

## **Schütz builds new Scandinavian IBC manufacturing plant**

Schütz Nordic has established a new IBC (intermediate bulk container) production facility and administrative offices in Kongsvinger, Norway, adjacent to its previous plant. Occupying a 20,000m<sup>2</sup> site some 100km north-east of Oslo, the premises provide a new three-layer extrusion blow-moulding unit, a new steel cage manufacturing facility and a full IBC production line. There is also an ultra-modern reconditioning plant in which all equipment has been designed and built according to the very latest standards. Here IBCs collected via the Schütz Ticket Service can be 100% recycled ecologically and economically. In other words, all of the recyclate produced can be reused in the production of components such as pallets and corner protectors for IBCs. The new plant offers significantly increased production capacity to serve customers in Norway, Sweden, Denmark and Finland.
