

## **Schütz to open Korea's first IBC plant**

In August, Clover Chemical & Co Ltd, Korean licensee for the world's foremost IBC manufacturer Schütz, will become the first manufacturer of rigid type intermediate bulk containers in Korea. Preparations for the installation of a new three-layer extrusion blow-moulding unit are already well underway. Clover staff will be invited to Schütz headquarters in Selters, Germany, to familiarise themselves with latest IBC production processes.



This month Clover is relocating its entire operation to Gyeongsang City, ideally situated from a logistics viewpoint in the east of the country some 100km from the port of Busan and 250km from the capital Seoul. Chairman Seon-Joong Kang and his management team will control the company's activities from Seoul, where the distribution office and finance department are also located.
