

Schütz opens second production plant in China

In the second half of April Schütz, Selters, Germany – the leading global manufacturer of IBCs (intermediate bulk containers) – opened its second manufacturing facility in China. The newly built state-of-the-art plant, occupying a 50,000m² site in the city of Tianjin in the north of the country, has been equipped with the latest technical infrastructure. Some 50 employees will produce both IBCs as well as the company's F1 tight-head PE drums. Production systems at the new plant, such as the three-layer extrusion unit for IBCs, all conform to the latest standards. A special feature is the exceptionally clean manufacturing environment which is in full compliance with regulations governing production of transport containers for the food industry, as specified for example by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA).
