

## ***Steinkühler chooses Dino road tanker loader***

Van Beek, Drunen, the Netherlands, has sold one of its Dino Silverline road powder tanker loaders to Germany-based bulk logistics operator Steinkühler who will employ the machine at its Krefeld depot for transferring the contents of bulk bags into road tankers. Previously the bulk bags had been emptied into the vehicles from above using a forklift truck, but the new system is both faster and safer. “After all, there is no need for anybody to be on top of the silo truck now”, commented Steinkühler’s Stefan Heger.

The machine in question is a Dino DR300 Silverline which can be supplied from stock offering a basic loading capacity of 40m<sup>3</sup>/h (or alternatively 80m<sup>3</sup>/h) and complies fully with harmonised European norms including Dutch working conditions (ARBO) legislation, statutory Belgian regulations on occupational exposure limits (ARAB) and the standards of the German technical inspection association (TUV). Every Dino machine, of which more than 350 are in use worldwide, is tailored to meet customers’ specific requirements.
