

Screw conveyors assist production of sultana biscuits

Van Beek of Drunen, the Netherlands, has designed three mobile inclined screw conveyors for Dutch biscuit manufacturer Koninklijke Verkade of Zaandam. The machines provide fast and efficient feeding of cinnamon sugar and syrup chips to the production process. Each unit offers a capacity of 2.5m³/h and raise the ingredients at an angle of 45 degrees to a height of 2m. They have been supplied with integrated control cabinets, providing 'plug and play' capability. When they are not in use they can be wheeled out of the way. www.van-beek.nl
